Art On The Rocks - Petroglyph Talk Story & Card Making Class

June 1, 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM

LYNN COOK is a freelance writer and artist who has researched ancient petroglyph rock art from New Caledonia to New Mexico and Huahine to Hawaii. Her new book, "Petroglyphs from Hawaii," published by Bess Press, is a journal style guide to adventures across the lava flows of Hawaii.

**ROCK ART:**

She will share the story of these ancient images and demonstrate techniques for turning them into art cards and wearable art. Materials will be available to create an individual art card and consider design options to enhance stitchery art projects.

In Hawai'i, the petroglyph, ancient rock art, is called Ki'i Pohaku. Ki'i meaning image and pohaku meaning rock. Images carved in stone are found around the world -- across the American Continent, Europe, Asia, Africa, Australia, Egypt and volcanic islands across the Pacific. They range in age from a hundred to many thousands of years old. The word petroglyph comes from the Greek petros - stone, and glyphe - carving or image.

**BUTTONS ROCK:**

Terry Nokell, *The Logger's Daughter*, after assisting with the creative card making, she will present her extensive collections of hand made earthenware buttons, new designs, and pendants. Terry is in Honolulu for her semi-annual week long trunk show at Silver Moon in Haleiwa and her First Friday, June 3rd show at the Louis Pohl Gallery on Bethel Street.
